# The impact of Interior Design on patient experience.

Design is all around us, and much of it we take for granted: our kitchen, our car, our clothes, coffee shops, and so on. When a Customer approaches your practice, they may well not realise how they are being influenced by the design of their surroundings.

The practice design can send a message, which signals to the Customer they are in a high-end, mid-range or budget premises. These signals start outside the premises, with your shop window, your signage and your external branding colours (if you have them).

Once they are through the front door, floor finishes, lighting, wall displays and so on all re-inforce a certain feeling for the Customer. And this feeling will continue as they approach the Reception area, wait in a seating area, and are taken through for an eye examination. So it follows that it may be time well spent to consider what sort of patient experience you would like your Customers to have, and tailor their visit to your practice accordingly.



You may not want to appear too expensive, as this could lose you new Customers. On the other hand you may be actively hoping to position the practice mid to high end, and therefore it may be good to look quite expensive. Or you may wish to have different zones, with a different feel in each zone. Our Designers are accustomed to working to different briefs, and can create a scheme for you which uses design to send the signals you want to send. The other crucial aspect of Interior Design that affects your Customer experience, is the smooth working of practical and functional tasks which need to be carried out in the practice: booking patients in, patient waiting, paperwork, the eye examination, dispensing, collections, payment and so on. Good design helps the work flow and helps that patient experience to be an excellent one.

# The latest Interior Design trends

As an Interior Design and Fit-out Company we enjoy being at the forefront of emerging trends. Our Designers love their chosen subject, and are in tune with the wider Interior Design Industry, both residential and commercial. This helps them recognise the latest trends and fashions. In general terms in the Optical market, we are working with more and more Customers who want a really lovely, mid to high end practice. They want their patients to feel that they are somewhere professional, yet which is not too scary and clinical.

The trend of incorporating Hearing Care continues, and this generally means creating a special room for this. The patient flow has to work well, and the practicalities of operating a busy practice must be catered for. A refurbishment is an opportunity to get this right.

To look at specific trends on the Optical side, one is the wish to display fewer spectacle frames, but to display them more elegantly. Not so many seem to want to display more



than 500 or 600 frames, with 300 to 400 being more typical. Surplus stock is often stored in frame drawers, which are easily accessible and may be chosen with a glass top to allow the contents of the top drawer to be seen.

Privacy while dispensing is frequently required, especially among higher end practices, and this could take the form of a low level partition, a slatted partition, or similar. LED lighting adds so much to frame display that this is also something we often incorporate within displays. The display island is also proving a winner, and we have designed many variants along this theme. Some of them double up as an informal overflow dispensing space.

In terms of flooring, wood effect vinyl flooring remains popular, but concrete or stone effect tiles can also bring a contemporary feel. Consulting rooms are still often fitted out with carpet, though luxury vinyl tiles are becoming more popular. There are many more, so do call us if you would like to explore this further.

# How much does a refurbishment cost?

It's hard to generalise on the cost of a refurbishment, because it all depends on how much needs to be done. For example, is it just a refresh of the frame display in the retail area, or does the floor need replacing, the ceiling, the lighting and so on? Do the consulting rooms need to be refurbished, or perhaps an additional one or two added? Is new airconditioning needed, a new shopfront, new signage etc?

We generally have to go through a questionnaire with our Customers to determine their wishes, and may also visit them, measure up and get a feel for the space. However, we can hopefully give some guidance: Some Customers may spend £2,000 - £3,000 on some new wall displays or a feature display. Other Customers may want a refresh of the



retail area, on a tight budget for say £25,000 to £30,000. A complete re-vamp of the retail area, with new flooring, lighting, electrics, decoration, air-conditioning, displays and furniture could be in the range of £40,000 - £70,000 with the overall size of the space having a big influence.

If the whole practice needs to be re-located and new consulting rooms built, therefore starting with a blank canvas to create a new Optical premises, this could range from £60,000 to over £100,000. All plus VAT. Larger premises could be a fair bit more than this. However, don't be afraid! A refurbishment is an investment in your business, and can set you apart from the competition. We see so many of our Customers delighted that they have done it, reaping the rewards by winning new Customers, motivating their team and set for a great future. Finance companies, many of whom we work with can help with lease finance, or hire purchase, so that the cost of a refurbishment can be spread over a number of years.

# Window Displays

Of all elements within visual merchandising, window displays are often the most direct in attracting potential new customers. ## Array System

The Array is a cable system attached to the ceiling at the top, and either the floor or a window bed or display plinth at the bottom.
